- Supporting network development and exchange between domestic and foreign artists and art professionals;
- Building Korean contemporary art's infrastructure and reinforcing international promotion;
- Sharing experience between domestic and foreign artists;
- Providing an environment for making experimental works and exploring new possibilities;
- Operating space as a public studio.

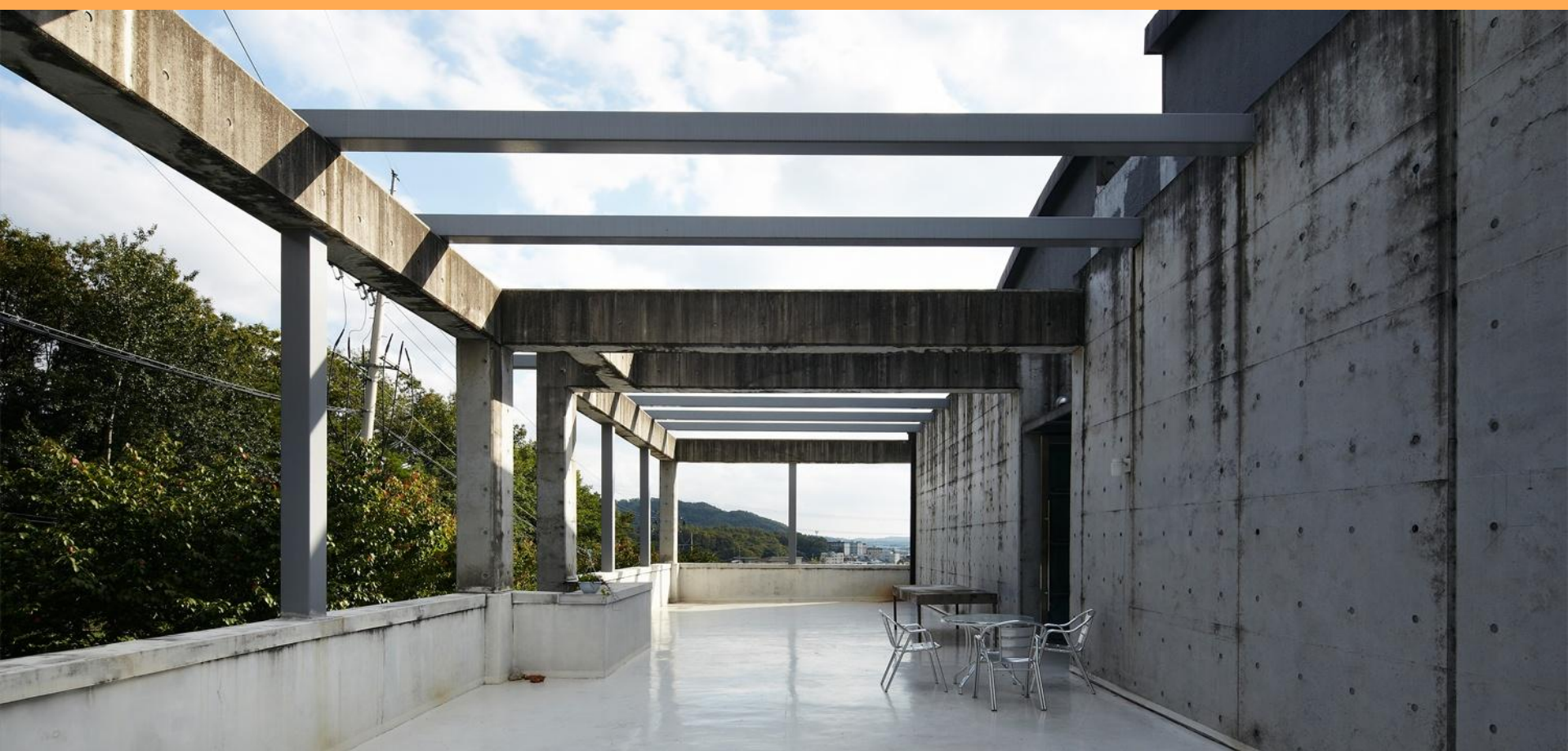

# Exhibitions



Consistently opening exhibitions of alumni and current resident artists in domestic art museums, overseas Korean Cultural Centers and exhibition spaces in National Art Studio, we make artists to show their new works and promote at home and abroad.



# Open Studio



Annual Open Studio, the heart of the MMCA Residency shows creative work of the resident artists during their residence to art scene and public.

# Art Professional's Visiting Program



We invite highly active specialists in the art world including curators, art directors, critics and journalists to National Art Studio in order to improve artistic creativity as well as broaden human infrastructure of resident artists.

# Workshops & Seminars



Alumni and current resident artists, curators, theorists share their ideas and talk about various subjects and discourses in contemporary art and artist-in-residence programs.

# Korean Language Course



We offer Korean language course for international artists to learn basic skill in reading and speaking in Korean. This program is helpful to buy art material and communicate in Korean art field.

# Cultural Excursion



We provide various opportunities to international artists to experience Korean culture as well as support to build a network by arranging a meeting with professionals in the art field.



# Publications



Catalogues of artists, open studio, exhibitions are published in Korean and English, and distributed to major art museums, galleries and artist residencies both nationwide and overseas.

We organize domestic exchange programs with specialized residencies. Participant artists can elevate the creative motivation in a new environment that has facilities and specialized programs.

# International Residence Exchange Program

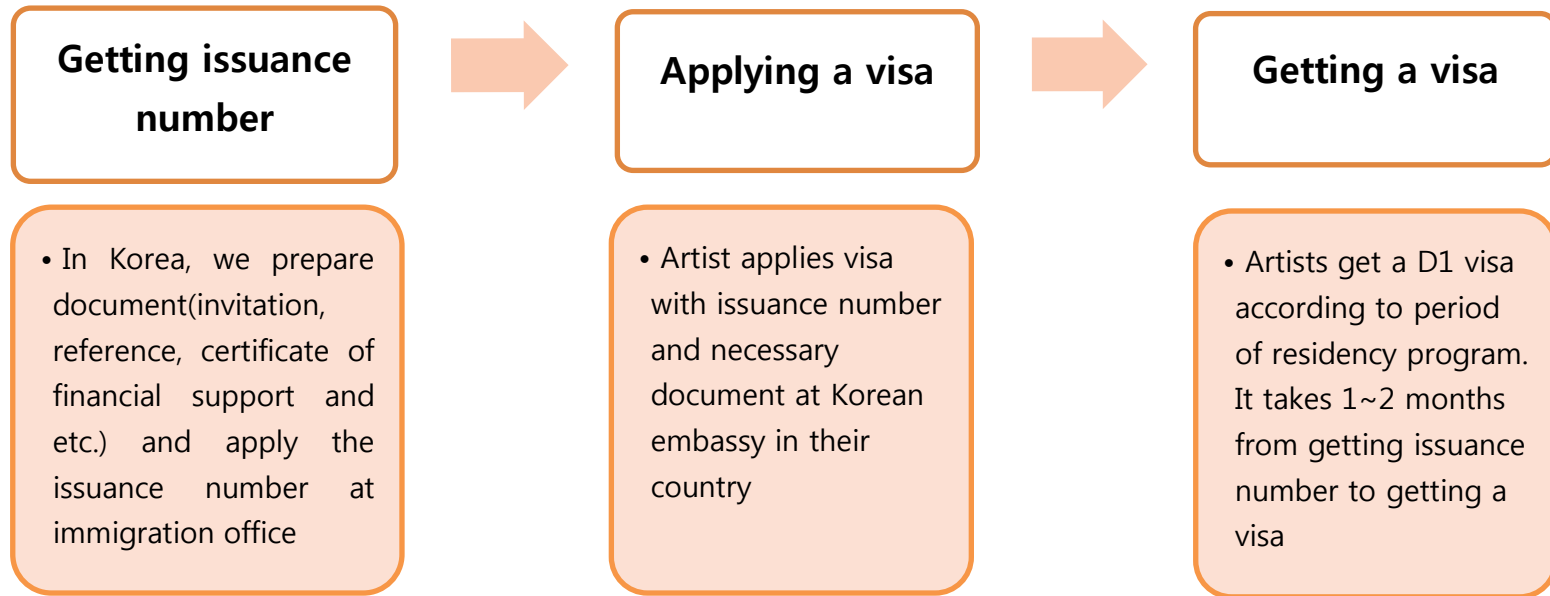

<b>Qualification</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Artists who are recommended by institutions</li><li>• Without prior resident experience to MMCA Residency</li><li>• Over 25 years old</li></ul>
<b>Resident Period</b>	3 months: April~June / July~September / September~December
<b>Number of Artists</b>	8 for 2015, 2 from each countries
<b>Priorities of Foreign Countries in 2015</b>	4 countries having anniversary of diplomatic relationship with Korea (Czech, Egypt, France, Japan, Singapore and etc.)
<b>Support</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Private studio including accommodation space inside (free of charge)</li><li>• Allowance (KRW 1,000,000 monthly)</li><li>• Opportunities of programs</li></ul>
<b>Recommendation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• List of 6 artists from</li><li>• Submissions: application, portfolio, recommendation letter, resume, pre-project plan</li><li>• Period: October ~ December, 2014</li></ul>

# Visa

We help artists who stays in Korea for more than 3 months to apply and receive Korean visa(D1 type).

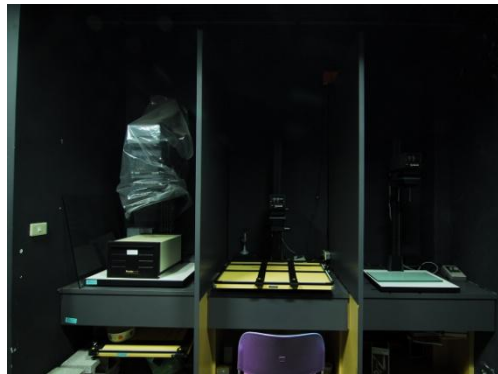
