Gallery




Gallery is not only a space for artists-in-residence exhibitions, but it also holds seminars, workshops etc.

Public workshop at the back yard is designed in order to provide a space for work with big scale installations and sculptures.








### Korean Language Course




We offer Korean language course for international artists to learn basic skill in reading and speaking in Korean. This program is helpful to buy art material and communicate in Korean art field.

We provide various opportunities to international artists to experience Korean culture as well as support to build a network by arranging a meeting with professionals in the art field.





#### Visa

We help artists who stays in Korea for more than 3 months to apply and receive Korean visa(D1 type).

### Getting issuance number

• In Korea, we prepare document(invitation, reference, certificate of financial support and etc.) and apply the issuance number at immigration office

#### **Getting** a visa

 Artists get a D1 visa according to period of residency program.
 It takes 1~2 months from getting issuance number to getting a visa

#### 3. International Residence Exchange Program

In association with eight institutions in overseas and several domestic specialized artist residencies, we provide opportunities to current resident artists to participate the other artist-in-residence programs. In the principle of mutual exchange, artists in partner institutions also interact with our resident artists staying at MMCA Residency.









